It's where students from the Christian Unions from the five Perth universities get together for a life changing time.

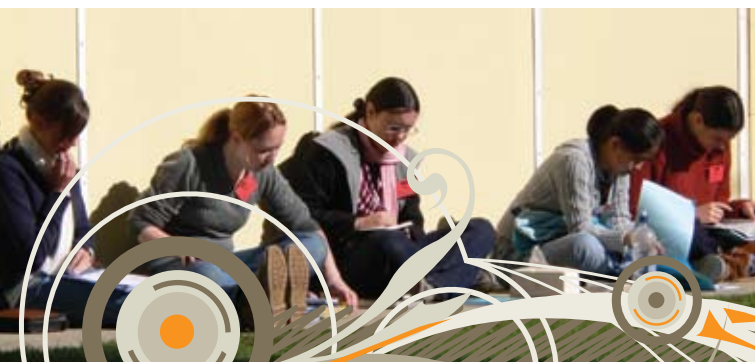
We spend five days together seriously exploring God's word, enjoying each others' company and having a great time together.
